SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Hexham & District Motor Club will promote the Northern Dales Classic Trophy on Sunday 15^d July 2018, the event will be held at Eastgate Cement Works, Weardale MR. 92/ 950385.
2. The event will be held under the General regulations of the Motor Sports association incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA and these Supplementary Regulations together with any written instructions that may be issued for the event.
3. The event will be open to members of the organising club plus Clitheroe DMC, NESCR0, HRCR, Berwick & DMC, Beverley & DMC, Durham A.C., Hadrian MC ,Kirkby Lonsdale MC, Wigton MC, SOSCC, Spadeadam MC, Preston MC, Rotherham MC, Hartlepool & DMC, Stockton & DMC, Whickam & DMC.
4. All vehicles will be scrutineered for eligibility, noise and safety. The vehicle registration document must be available and the vehicle presented must be the vehicle described in the registration document. Cars must comply with Regulation M.18. Any vehicle registered after 31.12.1981 must enter either Class M.1 or M.2
5. The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes finally, on 08/ 07/ 2018. Scrutineering opens at 08:00 on 15/07/2018, the first car will start the event at 10:00 on 15/07/2018.
6. All tests will take place within the Eastgate Cement Works, there will be no mileage on the public highway.
7. There will be a designated number of tests on private and, these tests will be as shown in the test diagrams. The whole test may not be visible from the start line. Competitors should be ready to start when instructed to do so by the start marshal. All test will finish with a "Stop Astride" line.
8. Classes will be as follows :
9.
 - H1. Cars manufactured before 31. 12. 1968
 - H2 Cars manufactured 31.12.1968 to 31.12.1981 under 13ft long
 - H3. Cars manufactured 31. 12. 1968 to 31.12.1981 over 13ft long
 - M1. Cars manufactured after 31.12.1981 up to 13ft long
 - M2. Cars manufactured after 31.12.1981 over 13ft long

N.B. At the instructions of the landowners, we cannot accept any Four Wheel Drive vehicles.

10. Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close, finally, on 08/ 07/ 2018, all entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the full entry fee (£85), the entry fee will include entry, competition numbers and lunch and tea. Entry can be paid by bank transfer, cheques sent by post should be made payable to Hexham & District Motor Club. All entries will be acknowledged. The maximum entry for the event is 50, these will be accepted on receipt of paid entry.

12. Awards :- 1st. Crew Overall , (Classes Hi , H2 & H3) : The Northern Dales Classic Trophies
 1st. Crew Overall, (Classes M1, M2 &) : The Northern Dales Targa Trophies
 1st. Crew in each class : Engraved Awards
 Additional Awards may be announced at the organisers discretion.

13. Provisional results will be announced at the conclusion of the event, any protests must be made in accordance with current MSA regulations.

14. Competitors will be issued with test diagrams and time cards at signing on.

15. Competitors will be identified by numbers supplied by the organisers which should be affixed on each side of the car.

16. The onus in obtaining a correct time lies entirely on the competitor. In the event of a query, the time recorded on the time card will be deemed to be correct. Penalties will be as General Regulations , section M, M7.

17. Competitors under the age of 18 years must have the entry form countersigned by a parent or guardian.

18. Any amendments to the Supplementary Regulations will be advised in the final Supplementary Regulations or on the official notice board.

19. As the whole of the event is on private land, vehicles do not need to be taxed but should be capable of passing an M.O.T. and suitable for this type of event.

20. Car sharing will be permitted at the organisers discretion, please contact for details.

21. Competitors who may be accompanied by a Navigator under 16 years of age must state this on the entry form.
